

Temple Day: Ta Nei.



In these weeds, there were many small, pretty flowers. The flowers attract the insects. There were too many (and they were too quick) for us to photograph them all.

















Thursday afternoons means language class. The new school is a much newer building and is nearer our apartment.


Friday December 6th, 2024.

Seated figure carved at Krol Ko.




