
Part 22 Europe for Cathy's blog

After another good breakfast, busier now at the hotel, we headed off to the market.




It's a beautiful building outside, but more like a warehouse on the inside. It might be quite touristy, but there were people buying meat and vegetables and fruit as well as paprika.



Those are strings of dried chilies hanging.




Here is a pretty lavender shop.

We found these tulips in a public park (probably the last days of tulips until next season...we won't see any again for a long while!).




More walking and more beautiful buildings and their wrought iron work.
