**I like the colour of this insect.**



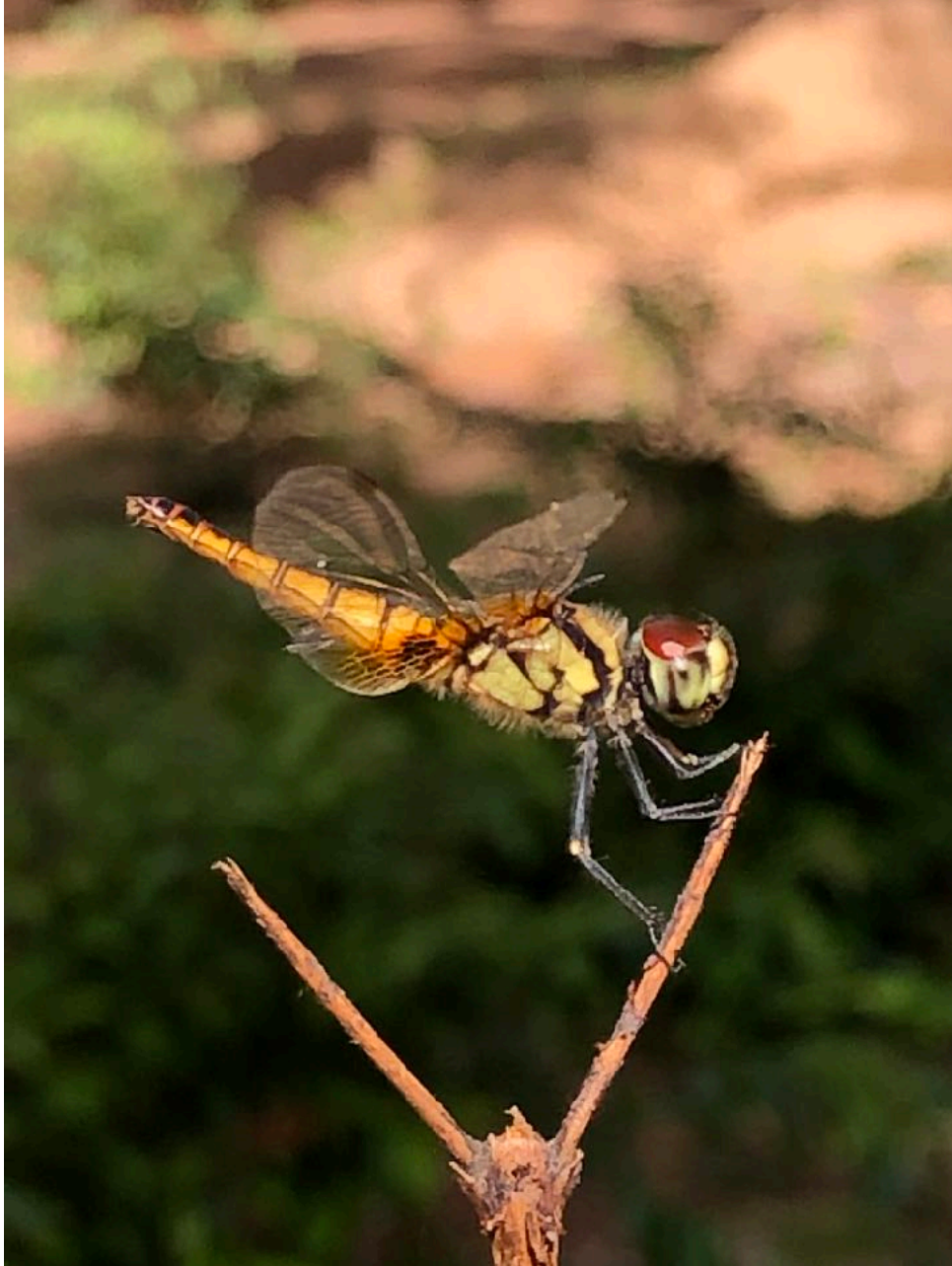
**The lions at the Eastern Terrace.**



**Orange Imperial butterflies on a new shoot.**



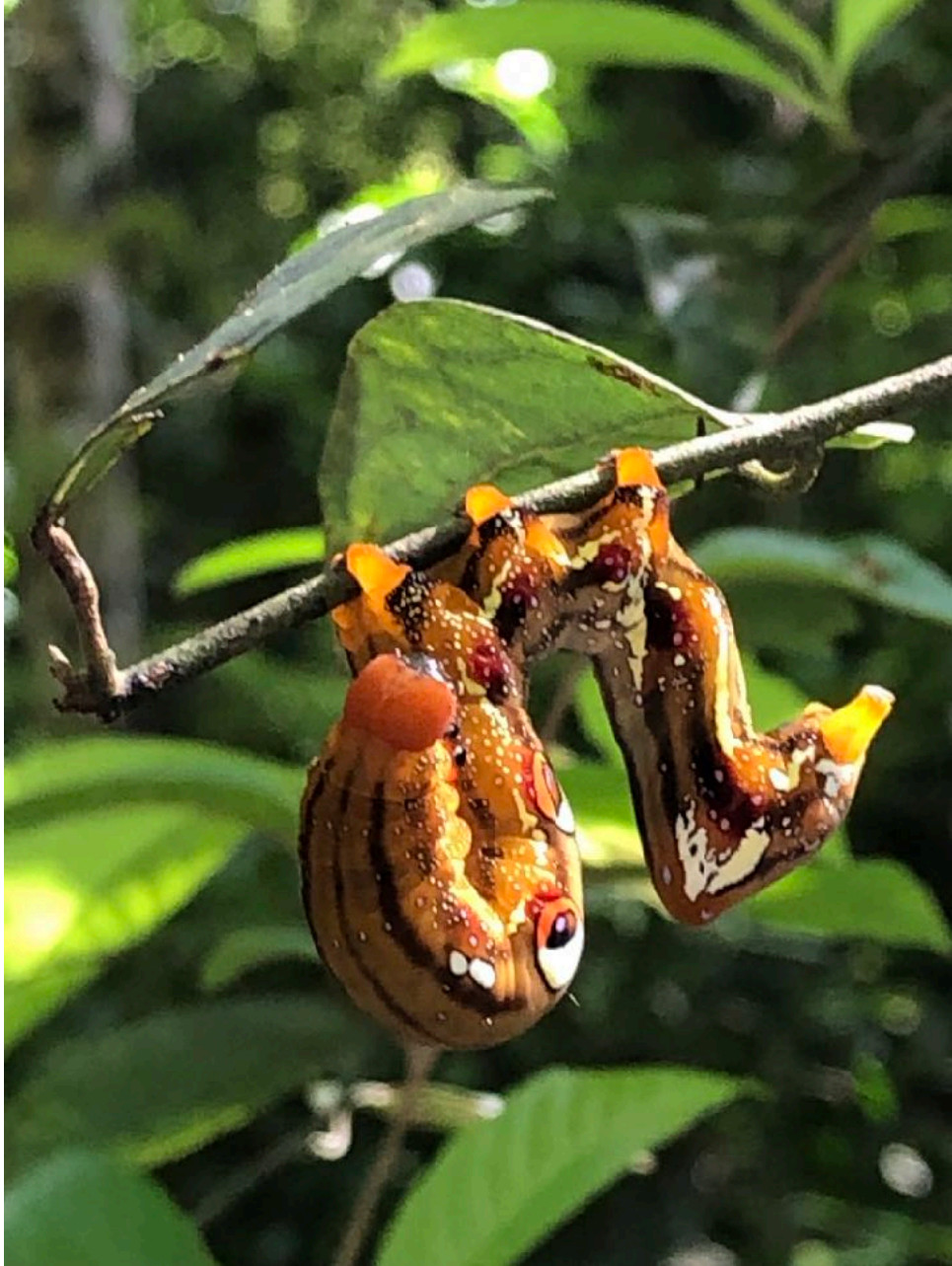
**Different fruit.**

On our way out this morning, I caught this photo of a cheeky monkey. I wonder if the driver knows he has a hitchhiker.





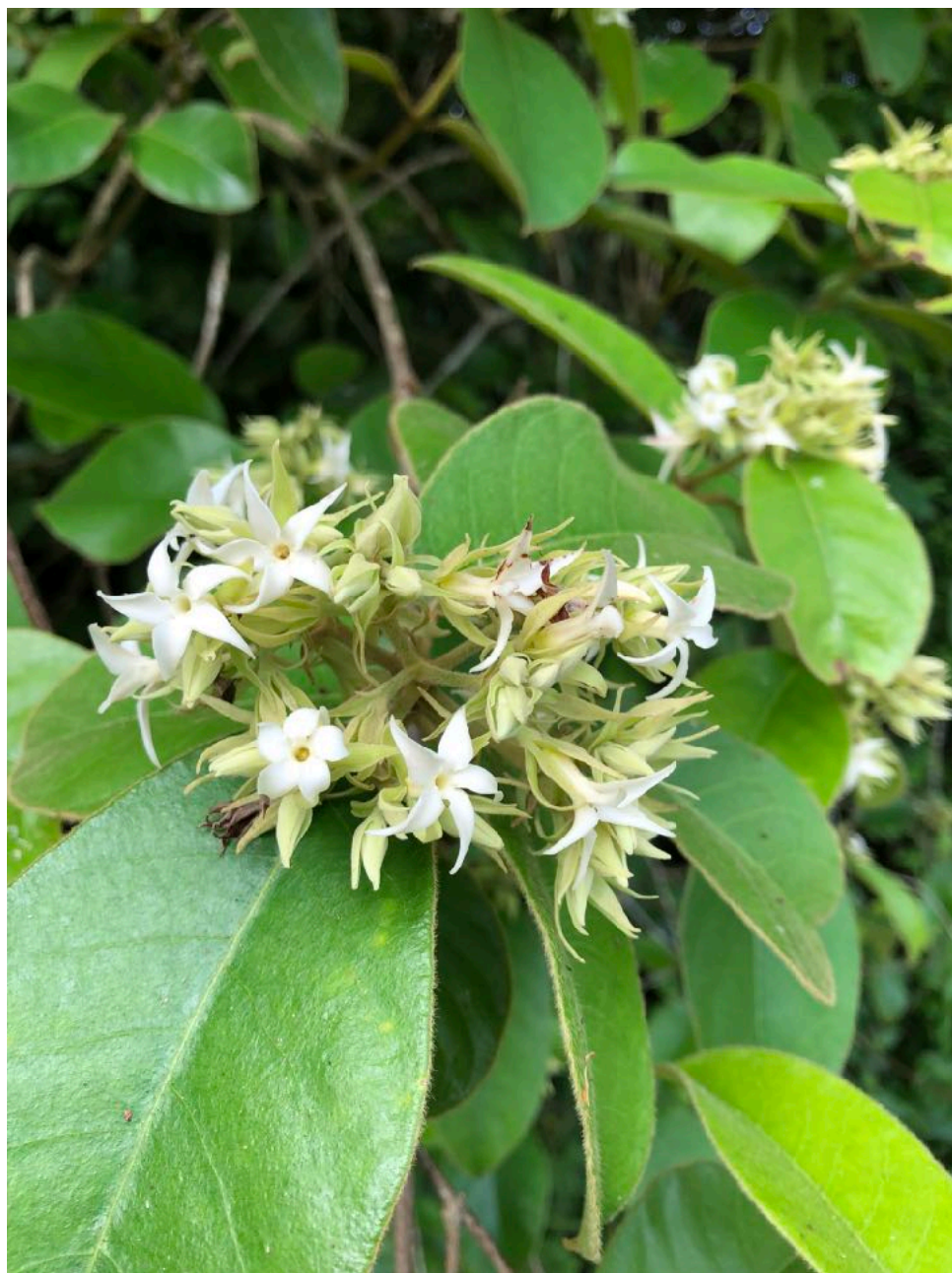
**This is what happens when you feed the monkeys in the car parks.**

The Bayon is in the centre of Angkor Thom and the four gates lie in the four cardinal directions from here.

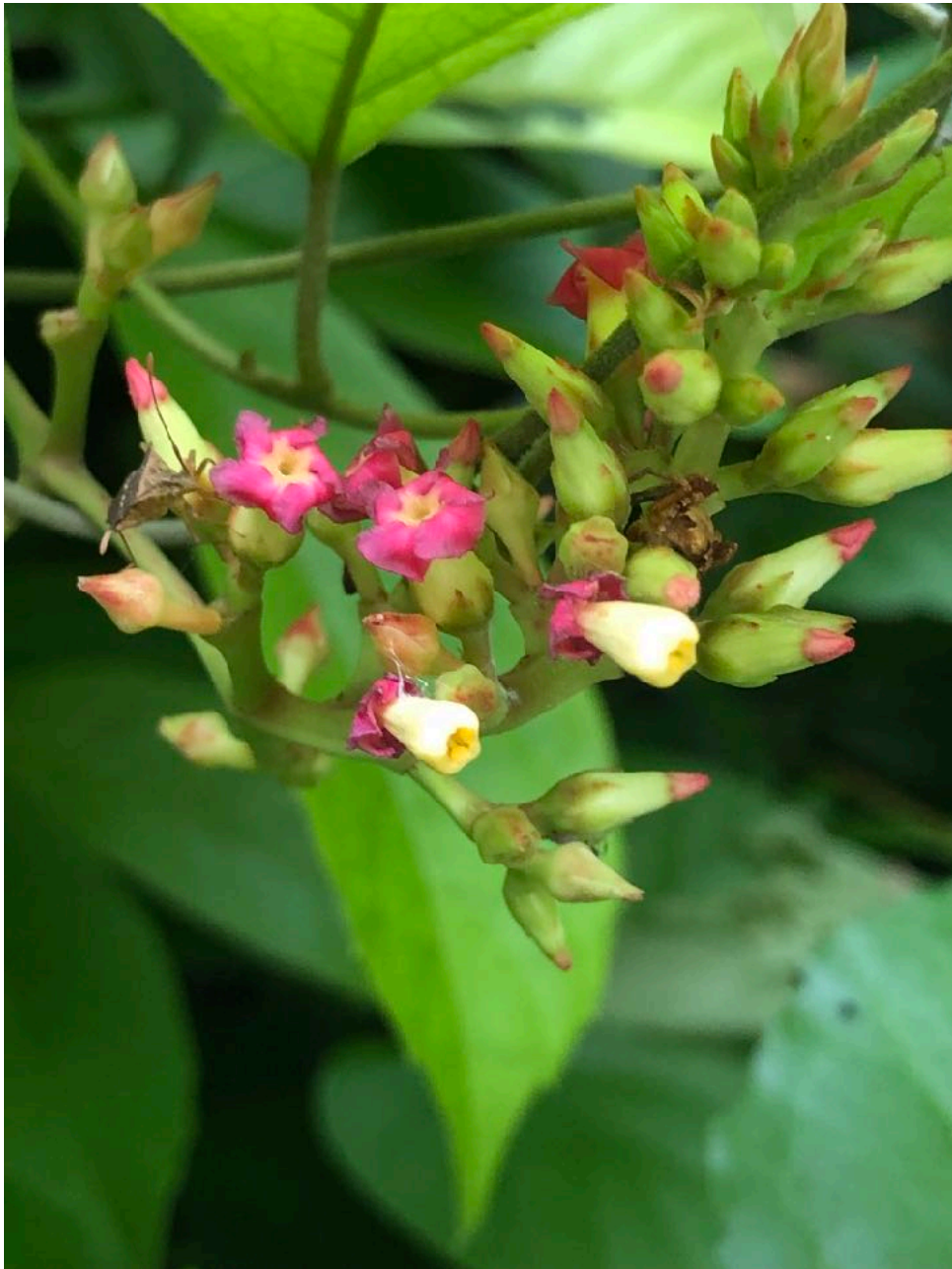
We park at the North Gate and walk up onto the path along the top of the wall.

**This is a new flower for us.**



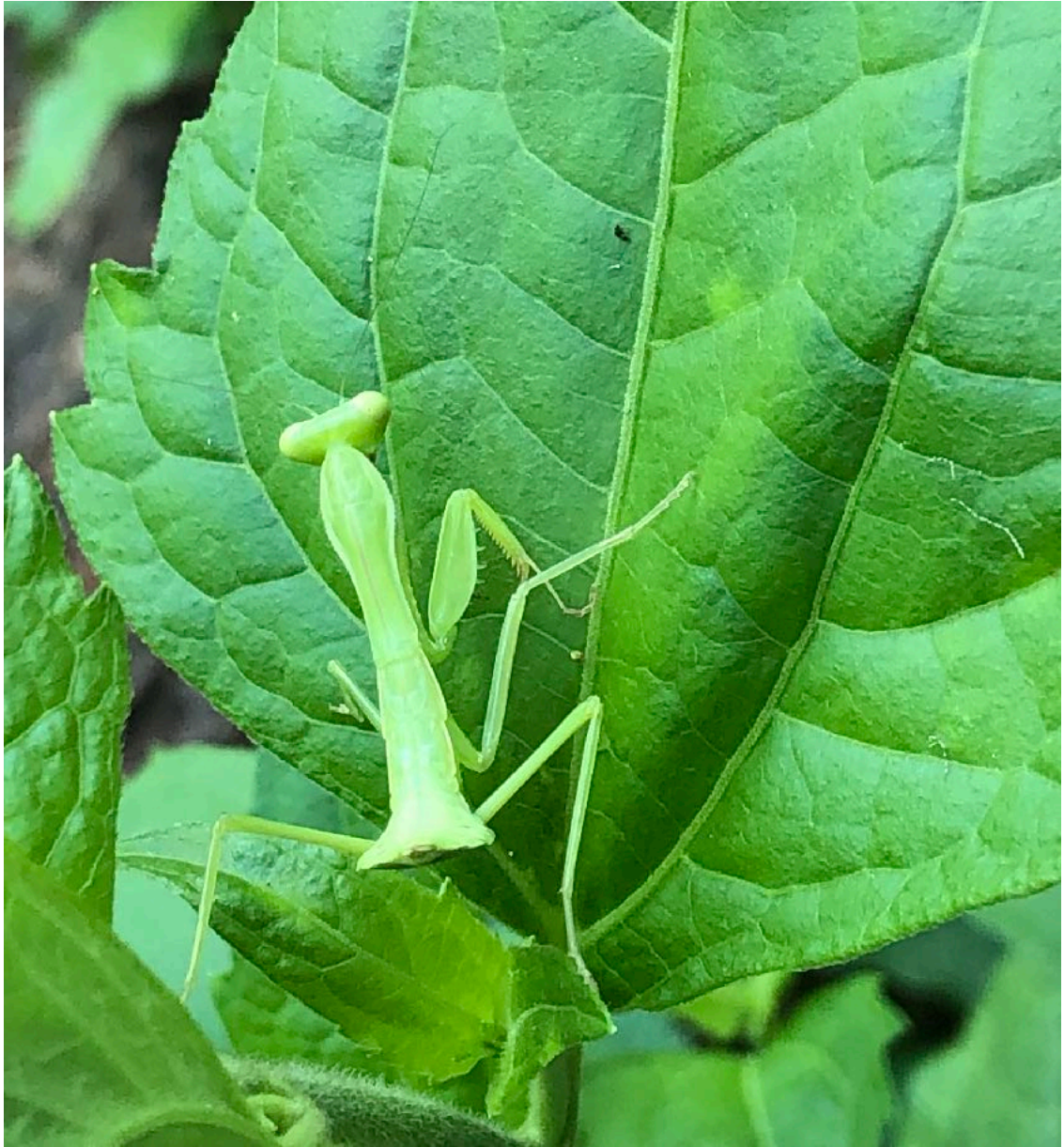
**This would be pretty if they were all open. Can you see the two insects?**

**Praying mantis.**



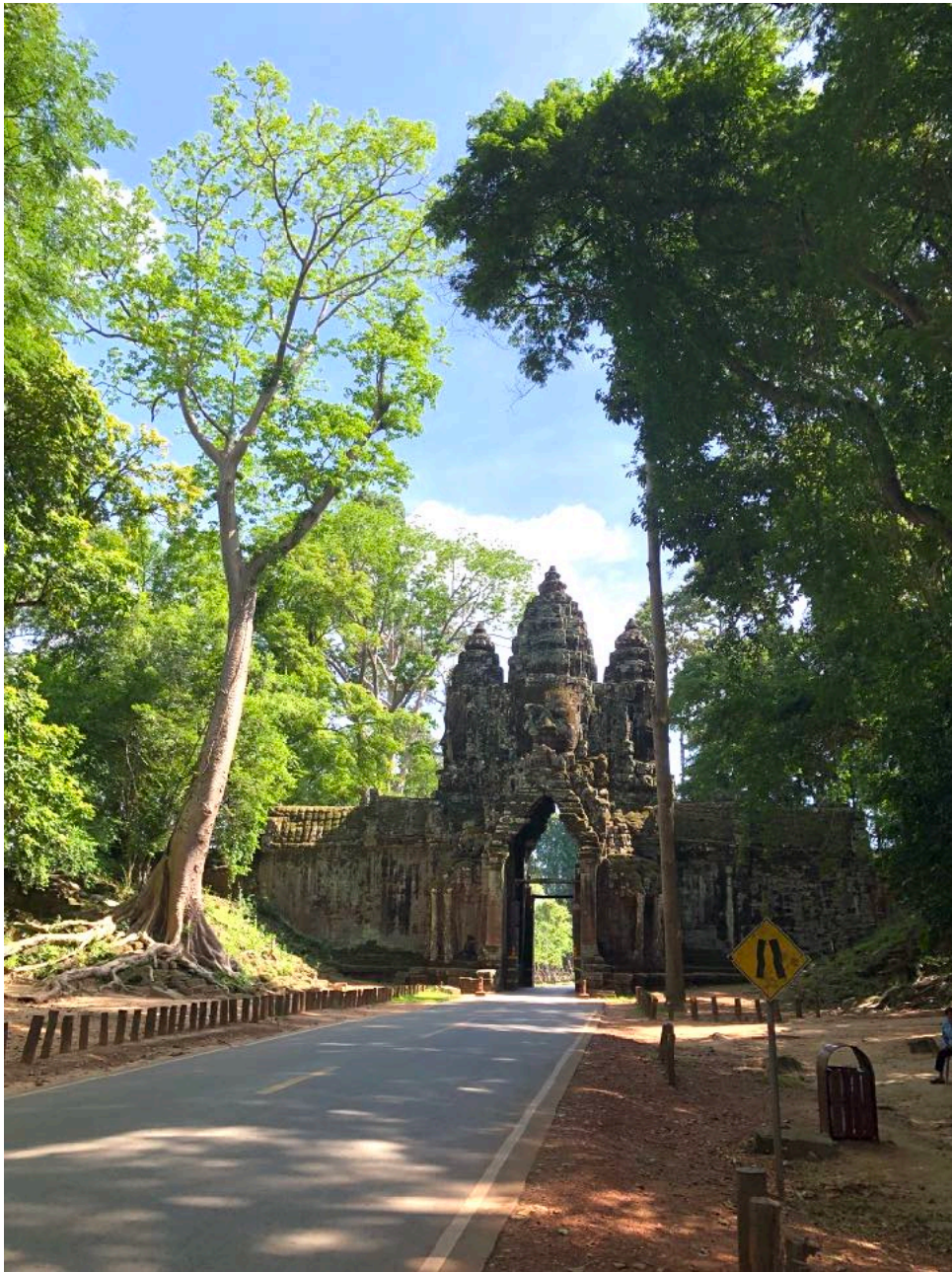
**Looper caterpillar... he was moving quickly to get off this sandstone block (to somewhere with some protection).**
